UNFINISHED BUSINESS



 - 1. Leave it a private road with the residents responsible for maintenance and contract with the town for its upkeep. 2. Go to court to get a determination on whether it is a private or town road.
 - 3. Undefined. To negotiate a compromise solution. More research will be done. Will be put on next month's agenda.
- 2. Driveway Ordinance Plan Commission will look over the ordinance and give they're ruling on the ordinance. Will be put on next month's agenda.
- 3. Possible Adoption of Dog Control Ordinance <u>Voice Motions by Supervisor Johnson and seconded</u> by Supervisor Anderson to adopt the Dog Control Ordinance. Motions Carried.
